purpose of grant

The purpose of the grant is to develop the following areas for the benefit of WasteMINZ members and the practice of waste management in New Zealand.

- promote and develop the science, art and practice of sound waste management
- promote and encourage research by members into waste management
- uphold and improve the quality of information available to members
- exchange knowledge both locally and internationally
- to promote continuing education for WasteMINZ members

value of grant

It is expected that the maximum grant to one applicant will not exceed \$3000.

application conditions

The following are the conditions that the applicants must adhere to:

- applicants must show support from their employer or tutor to undertake study or travel including any financial assistance
- applications must be submitted by 31 August by post, fax or email and be on the official application form
- objectives of the proposed application must be clearly stated
- applicants must be able to show that they can contribute financially to undertake the activity they are applying for
- recipients of grants must submit a full report within 3 months of the completion of their study.travel
- recipients must provide an agreed number of articles for the WasteMINZ magazine - Waste Awareness
- preference will be given to applicants who have a clearly defined project and who can demonstrate the benefits of the proposal to the wider waste industry in New Zealand

eligibility

Applicants [or their employer] must be a financial member of Waste Management Institute New Zealand Incorporated [WasteMINZ] at the date of application.

Successful applicants must begin their proposed study.travel within 12 months of their application being accepted, however they can apply to the Board to defer the grant due to:

- health
- the postponement of the course and being available again within another 12 months

applications

- 1 applications must be submitted on the official application form available from WasteMINZ [contact details on back]
- 2 applications can be submitted by post, fax or email providing they are on the official application form
- 3 the successful applicants will be announced at the WasteMINZ Conference held each year in October/November
