

Collecting good, nutritious surplus food and redistributing it to people in need.

Reducing Food Waste.

Relieving Food Insecurity.



What's the Impact?

Each day, on average, AFRA members:

- Rescue 20 tonnes of food
- Distribute 25 tonnes of food (rescued and donated)
- Provide the equivalent of 55,000 meals
- Prevent 56 tonnes of CO2e emissions to the atmosphere




