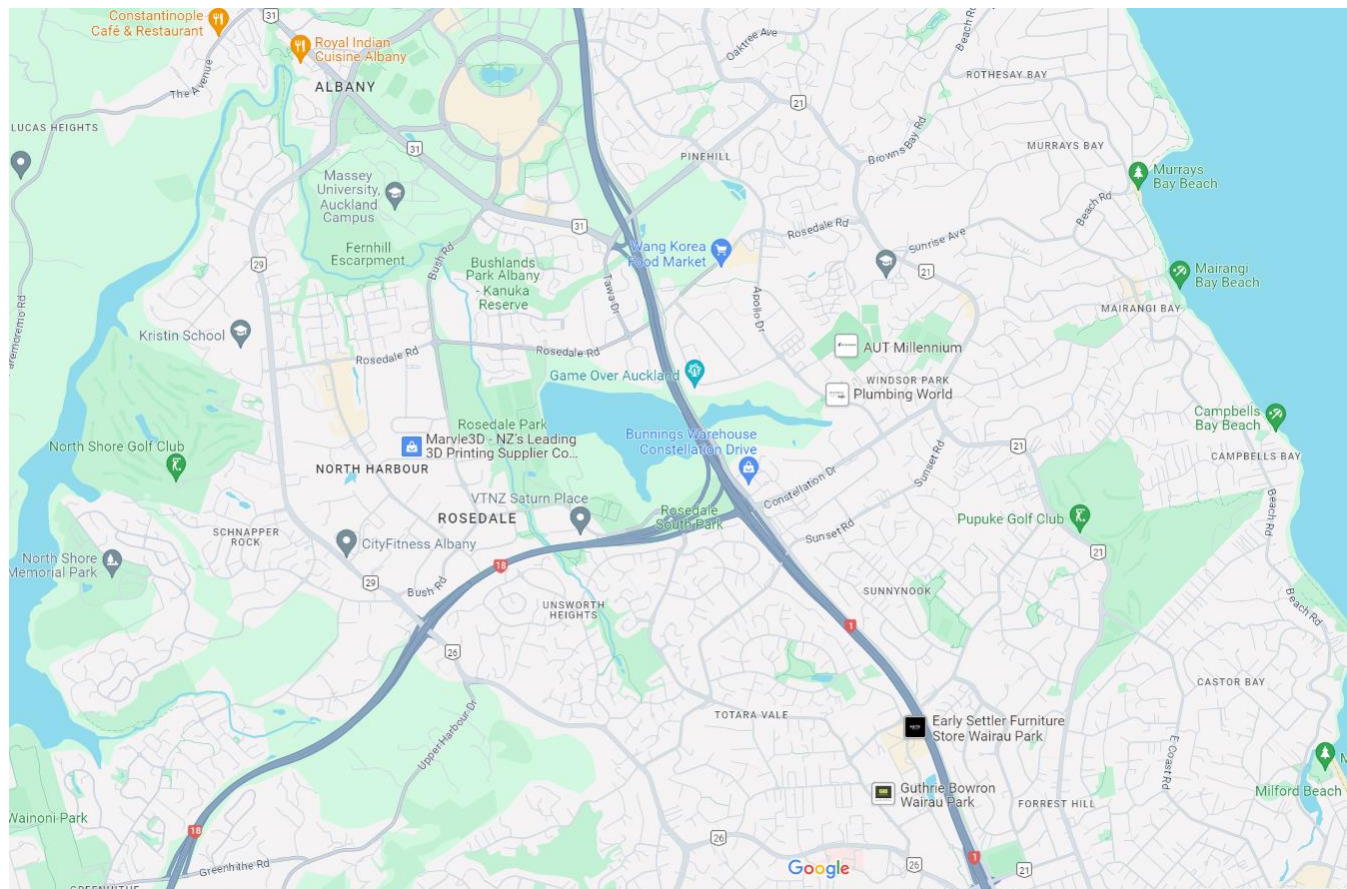

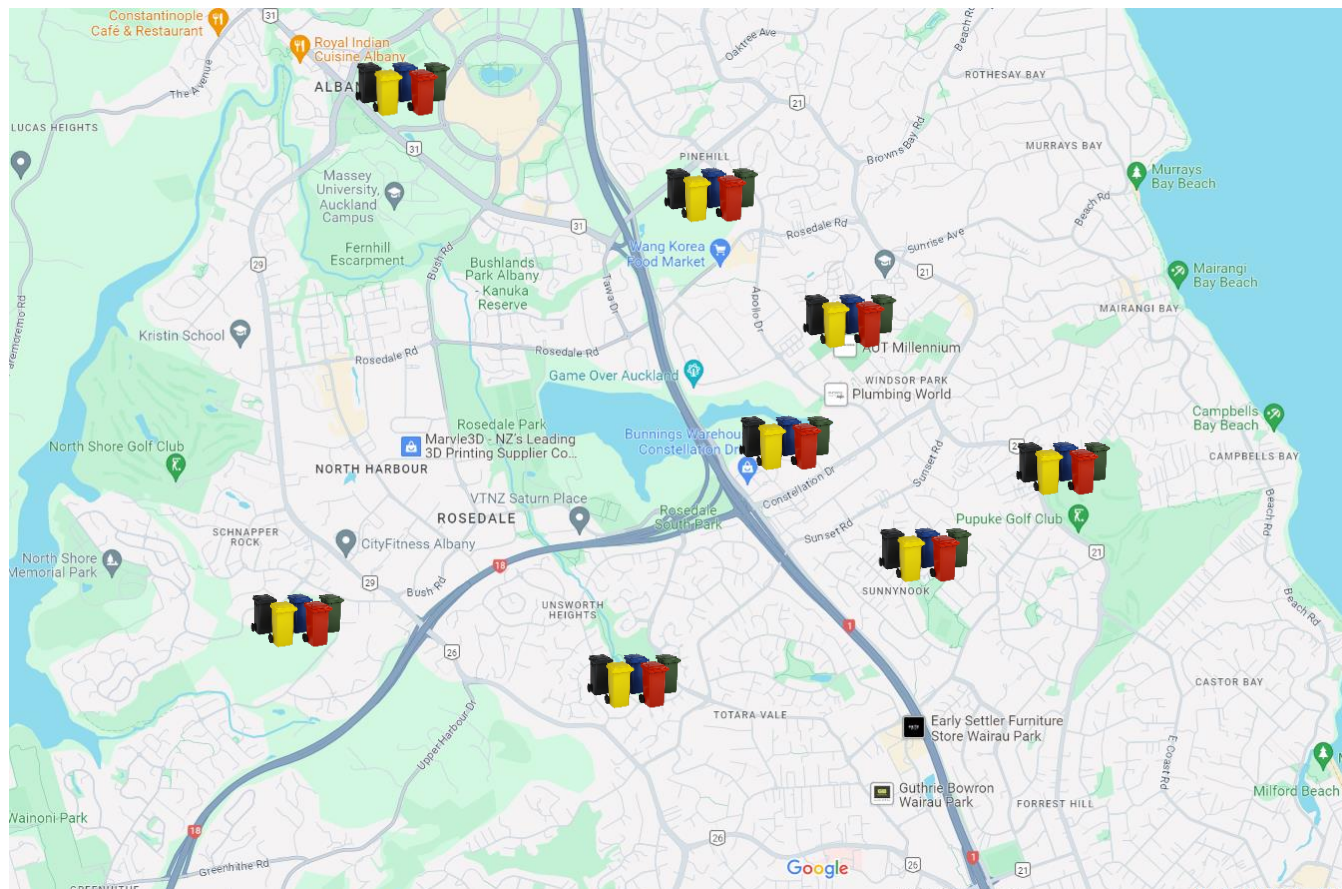

# Contracts and rates

## 1.23 Contingency Plan

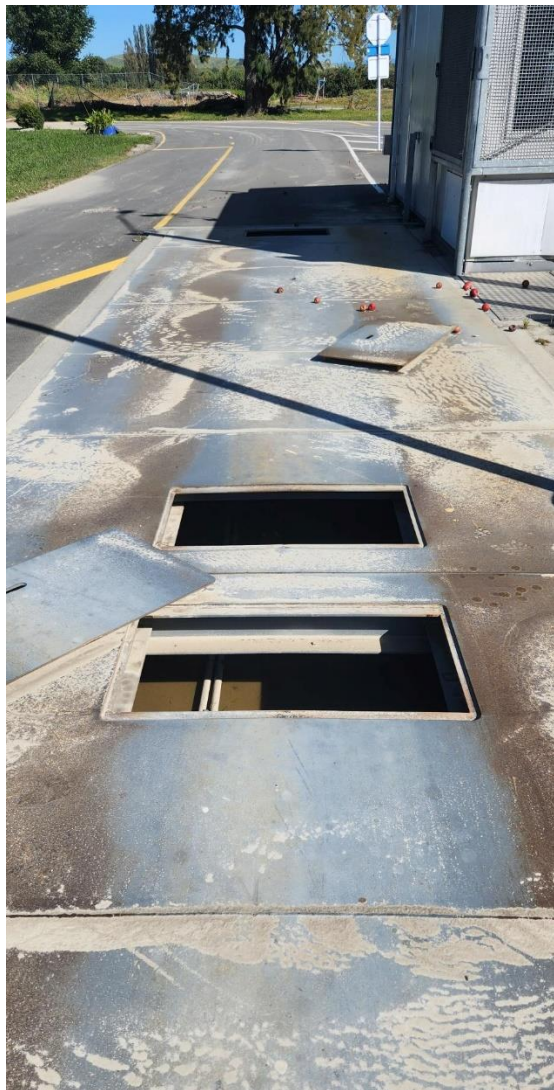
The Contractor shall prepare, in accordance with the timeframe in Appendix D - Deliverables, a Contingency Plan as part of the Operations Plan that ensures the Contractor provides the Services to the Council at no further cost in the instance of (but not limited to) the following events:

- (a) Unscheduled unavailability of multiple plant or Collection or transportation vehicles;
- (b) Unscheduled unavailability of staff or sub-contractor staff resources;
- (c) Inclement weather conditions requiring facilities to close;
- (d) Inclement weather causing delay to collections; and
- (e) Natural disaster.

Risks associated with a natural occurrence which impacts directly on the ability of the Facilities to operate in accordance with the Contract between the Contractor and Council will be assumed and managed by the Contractor in accordance with the Approved Contingency Plan.

In an extreme event such as Civil Defence emergency, Council may take control of the resources of the Waste Collection Services for a limited period.
