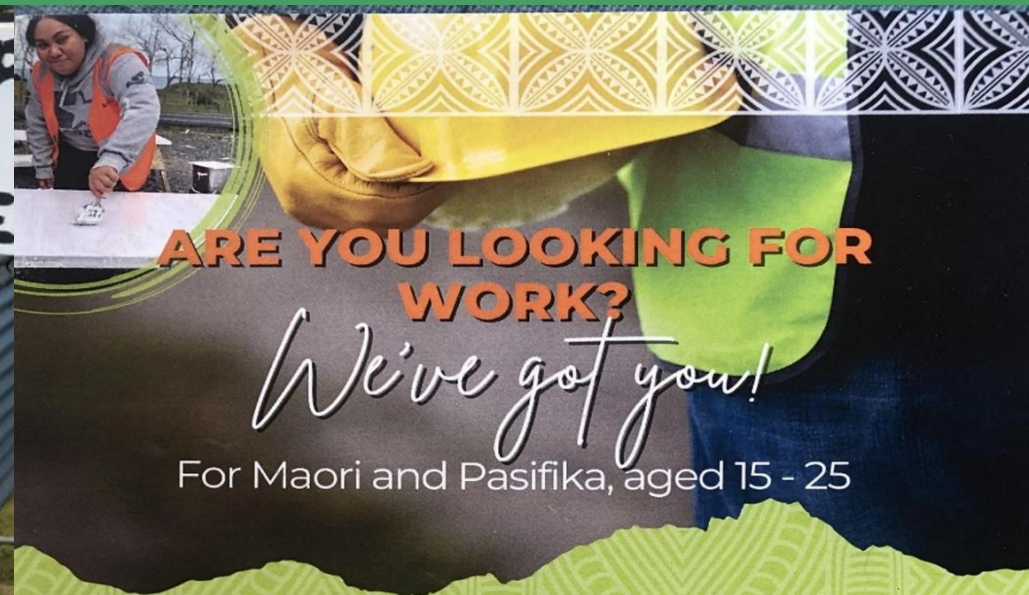

Construction Material Recovery and Reuse

To help construction companies reduce their waste, the Onehunga Community Recycling Centre (Onehunga CRC) is accepting some construction and demolition materials.

This material will be sold at Onehunga CRC, to fund this service. Material donated must therefore be undamaged and reusable.

Ideal materials and products include:

- Timber (min. length 1200mm)
Treated or untreated. **No offcuts**
- Clean Building Boards (min. 1200x1200mm)
- Bricks, Tiles, Kerbing, Pavers etc.
- Doors, Windows and Fittings
- Kitchens and Bathrooms (in tidy condition)
- Seconds or items with minor blemishes or imperfections
- One-off building materials
- Fixings and Hardware
- Roofing Materials
- Wool Insulation
- Cladding
