<b>Traffic Management Plan</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Approved TMP Plan in vehicle at all times.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Approved TMP Plan in vehicle at all times.</li> </ul>
<b>Briefing and Training</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Site Traffic Management Supervisor (STMS) to brief all staff in activity at regular intervals (minimum 3 monthly)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All drivers must be trained as a Waste Collection Traffic Leader 'WCTL'</li> <li>All mobile work teams must be led by WCTL.</li> <li>WCTL training to be renewed every 3 years.</li> <li>STMS must brief WCTL and all other staff in activity once every 6 months (documented).</li> <li>WCTL provides safety briefing to crew each day before activity commences (documented).</li> <li>All existing drivers must obtain WCTL by 1 January 2013.</li> <li>All new drivers must obtain WCTL within 4 months of commencement of employment</li> </ul>
<b>Resources</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All TMPs must be prepared by STMS.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All TMPs must be prepared by STMS. Reviewed yearly.</li> <li>One STMS per company. If company has multiple branches additional STMS may be required.</li> <li>The STMS is not required to be within 30 minutes of given site, but must respond to a call within 30 minutes.</li> </ul>
<b>Beacons/Signage/Other Devices</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The vehicle shall be fitted with 2 yellow (amber) rotating flashing beacons and a rear mounted TW-34 Pass with Care Sign. Beacons and signs must be visible from the rear.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Each vehicle must have installed <b>3</b> amber beacons, 1 at the front, 2 at the rear (highest most practical extremes of the vehicle). The vehicles hazard warning lights must not be used as amber beacons.</li> <li>All work vehicles must have a TV4 (TW-34) PASS WITH CARE SIGN (meet Traffic Control Devices 2004 rule), shape and size is a rectangle 900x450mm.</li> <li>All vehicles must have an audible operating reversing warning buzzer installed to warn workers and public.</li> </ul>

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		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All vehicles must have an operational rear-mounted camera with an active monitor in the cab for the driver.</li> <li>• All vehicles must display a reflective panel (red/white) across the rear of the vehicle. (This may be limited by the rear configuration of the vehicle and it is a matter of doing the best that you can with the vehicle).</li> </ul>
<b>Visibility</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All staff involved must wear a CoPTTM compliant safety garment.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All staff involved must wear a CoPTTM compliant safety garment.</li> </ul>
<b>Regulation</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Vehicle operates to Traffic Regulations and the Road Code and keep to the left side of road.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Vehicle operate to Traffic Regulations and the Road Code</li> </ul>
<b>Operational Requirements</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Operations must take place outside the peak flow times</li> <li>• On Level 2 and 3 roads the times of operation shall be defined by Road Controlling Authority.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The Road Controlling Authority may restrict the hours of operations on some roads.</li> <li>• As above.</li> </ul>
